### Job Summary:

- Coordinates and leverages functional capabilities to meet site manufacturing, PSM and workplace safety needs.
- Provides leadership to the capital processes, including scope and basic data development, project oversight and equipment commissioning.
- Provides organizational leadership, including mentoring of junior team members.
- Network with peers and leverage knowledge from other functions and corporate groups.
